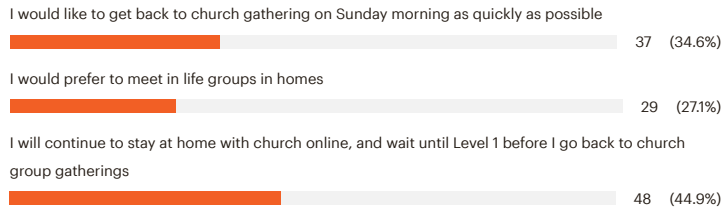


Church under Level 2

All Responses

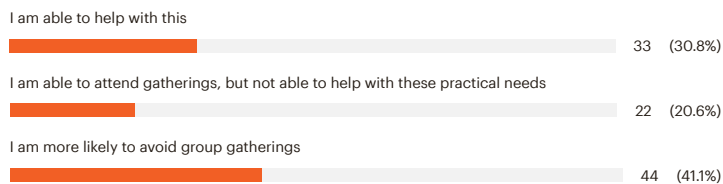
Question 1 has 107 answers (Checkboxes)

“Based on current guidelines, we will be able to gather in groups of up to 50 when we are at Level 2. What are you most likely to do at Level 2 on Sunday mornings?”



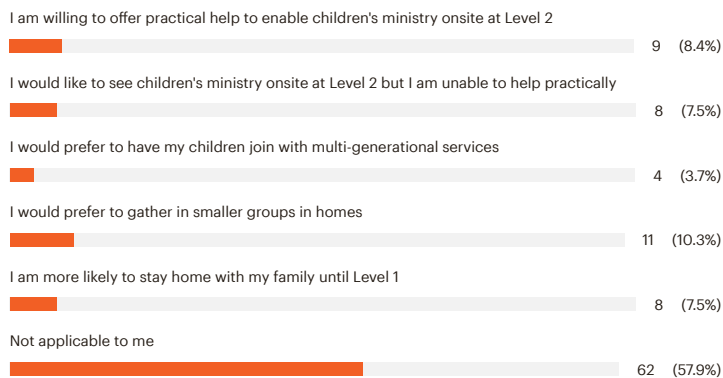
Question 2 has 98 answers (Checkboxes)

“Under Level 2 guidelines, we would need extra practical help to facilitate the requirements for managing gatherings and cleaning. Where do you see yourself in this?”



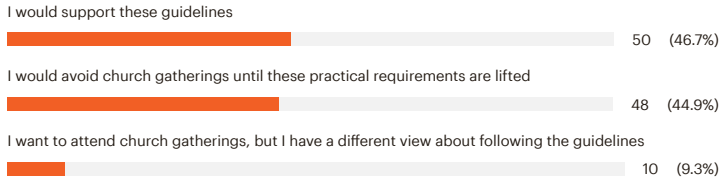
Question 3 has 98 answers (Checkboxes)

“For parents/caregivers with children, and others involved in children’s ministry. As you consider Level 2 restrictions:”



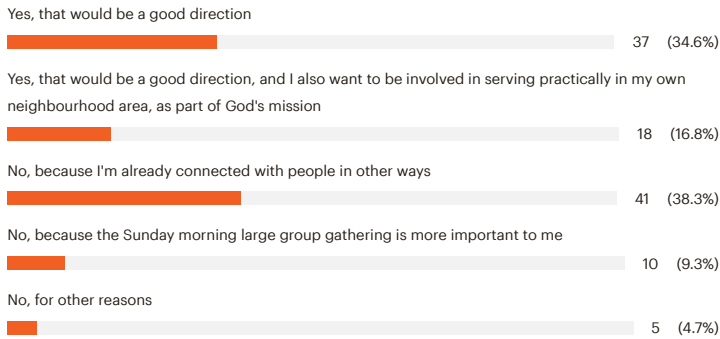
Question 4 has 106 answers (Checkboxes)

“At Level 2, general indoor gatherings require social distancing of 2m, registering attendance and face masks. What would be your response if Franklin Baptist church followed these requirements:”

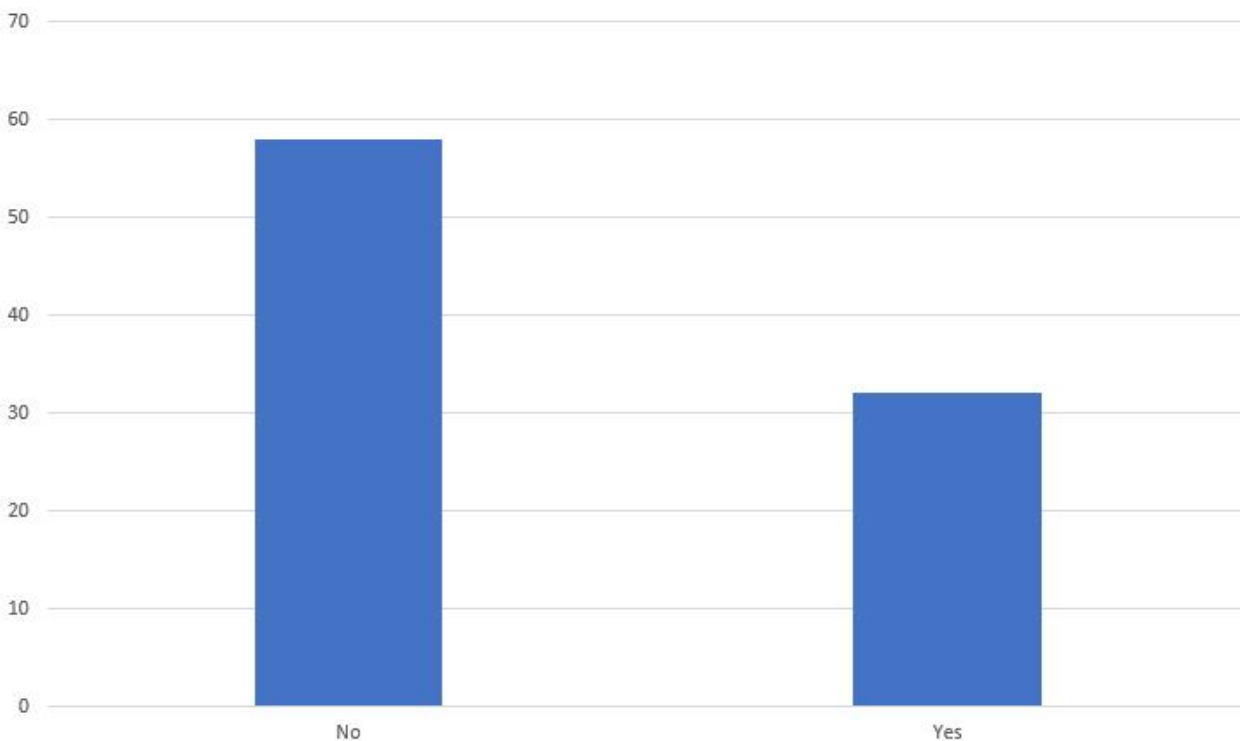


Question 5 has 105 answers (Checkboxes)

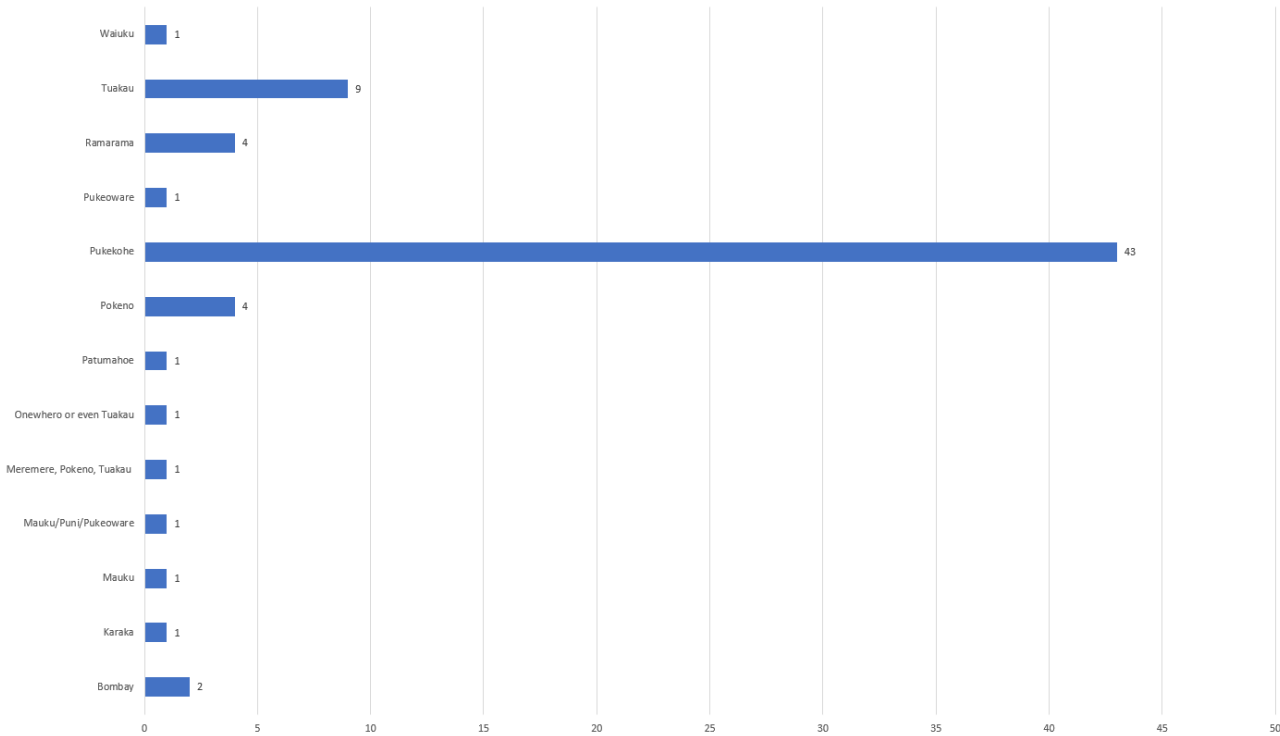
